The following establishments requested a hearing before the Licensing Appeal Tribunal regarding compliance issues and received suspensions of 14 days or more or revocations. Establishment	Infraction	Sanction
Area One, Markham	Serving minors; overcrowding; failure to ensure sale and service of alcohol supervised by authorized employee; permitted drunkenness; non-compliance with <i>Fire Protection and Prevention Act</i>	14 days

## Other Suspensions/Revocations

Suspensions of 14 days or more and revocations where the licensee did not request a hearing before the Licence Appeal Tribunal.

Establishment	Infraction	Sanction
Brigadoon Bar and Restaurant, Scarborough	Permitted drunkenness, riotous, quarrelsome, violent and disorderly conduct	14 days
HIGH-5KTV, Scarborough	Serving minors; failure to inspect identification; permitted drunkenness; permitted narcotics on premises; operated business without license transferred by the registrar; carried on business under a name other than the name set out on the license; failure to clear signs of service; failure to post sign in a conspicuous place concerning suspension; breach of condition of the establishment's liquor licence	30 days
Turntable Restaurant & Lounge, Mississauga	Overcrowding	18 days
