GENERAL DIRECTIVE NO. 1 – 2017 – Superfecta and Triactor Wagering

Preamble

WHEREAS after consultation with the public and industry with respect to the proposed rule changes, there was support to remove the previous General Directives with respect to superfecta and triactor wagering, which were as follows:

GENERAL DIRECTIVE NO. 2 – 2009 SUPERFECTA WAGERING

The Ontario Racing Commission at its meeting of Thursday, February 26, 2009, resolved that the following directive, effective March 26, 2009, replaces General Directive 6 – 2006 governing the Commission's policy on superfecta wagering, and supersedes all prior Commission directives pertaining to superfecta wagering.

Superfecta wagering in Ontario is approved for all races on any race program, where there are at least seven horses (seven separate betting interests) programmed to start.

GENERAL DIRECTIVE NO. 3 – 2009 TRIACTOR WAGERING

The Ontario Racing Commission at its meeting of Thursday, February 26, 2009, resolved that the following directive, effective March 26, 2009, replaces General Directive 2 – 2000 governing the Commission's policy on triactor wagering, and supersedes all prior Commission directives pertaining to triactor wagering.

Triactor wagering in Ontario is approved for all races on any race program, where there are at least five horses (five separate betting interests) programmed to start.

TAKE NOTICE that the Registrar hereby rescinds General Directive No. 2 – 2009 Superfecta Wagering and General Directive No. 3 – 2009 Triactor Wagering, and this decision shall supersede all prior Commission Directives pertaining to superfecta and triactor wagering, effective immediately.
