QUARTER HORSE DIRECTIVE NO. 1 – 2017 – Jockey Weights

Preamble

WHEREAS after seeking consultation from the public and industry with respect to the proposed rule changes, there was support in the quarter horse industry to revise jockey weight allowances;

TAKE NOTICE that the Registrar hereby orders the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing 2016 - Quarter Horse Appendix, be amended as follows effective immediately:

QUARTER HORSE APPENDIX

Chapter 8

WEIGHTS

8.04.02 All horses in Quarter Horse Racing must carry from ~~between~~ 116-120 lbs. up to and including ~~and~~ 127-130 lbs. An over weight allowance limited to 5 lbs. (five pounds) is allowed. All jockeys must declare their weight prior to riding the first race of any card and must ride at that weight for all races on that date. The aforementioned weight must be posted prominently before the public prior to the mutuels opening for any race in which any jockey rides.
