THOROUGHBRED DIRECTIVE NO. 2 – 2017 – Jockey Conflict of Interest Provisions

Preamble

WHEREAS after consultation with the public and industry with respect to the proposed rule change, there was support in the thoroughbred industry to revise the rule addressing potential conflicts of interest for jockeys;

TAKE NOTICE that the Registrar hereby orders the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing 2016 be amended as follows effective immediately:

Chapter 9

JOCKEYS

9.15.01 A jockey or an apprentice jockey shall not:

- (a) A jockey or an apprentice jockey shall not be an owner or trainer of any thoroughbred race horse.;
- ~~(b) Compete in any race against a horse owned or trained by his or her spouse;~~
- ~~or~~
- ~~(c) Compete in any race against a horse owned by his or her mother, father, brother or sister.~~
- (b) If a jockey or an apprentice jockey is entered in a race against a horse owned or trained by his or her spouse, mother, father, brother or sister, he or she shall provide reasonable notice of this to the Stewards.
