Chantal relayed her horse was lugging in strongly, so much so that she couldn't hit him left handed until she was able to get her horse off the inside horse. Omar said the pressure was from the outside. Bahen's horse came out but once the damage was done. We felt Chantal did her best to control her horse, no action taken.

Race 6 - #11 “Lion Lord” needed a front shoe tacked on in the paddock but was not cooperative so the other front shoe was removed. #11 “Lion Lord” is now a Steward scratch. #3 “Shelbourne” with Ismael Mosqueira turned over in the gate and was scratched by the Official Veterinarian. Subsequently #2 “Rock You” unseated Luis Contreras behind the gate and ran off and was scratched by the Steward.

Race 7 – Stewards Inquiry into the start regarding #1 “Audacious Bear” ridden by Luis Contreras and #3 “Splendid Glory” ridden by Kazushi Kimura. Luis said they were having trouble with #3 and yelling no, no and my horses head turned into the assistant starter and the doors opened, he still had a hold of my horse, had no chance to leave. Kazushi said his horse was acting up and they yelled not to go but the doors opened. The guy with me let go of me, ok. After review we ordered a refund of mutuels for #1 “Audacious Bear” due to an unfair start, however, #3 “Splendid Glory” was deemed to have a fair start.
