Backstretch:

09:25 – Exercise person Robert Stewart attended to address a ruling from Hastings Park in British Columbia. Mr. Stewart is currently suspended in B.C. and we reciprocate with other jurisdictions in matters such as this. Mr. Stewart said he didn't realize he was suspended only that he was barred from the grounds of Hastings Park. Mr. Stewart is suspended here in Ontario until such time as he deals with the matter in B.C.
