### 2018 Process and Required Documents

October 2, 2017 - A complete renewal application for a License to Operate a Teletheatre includes the following documents, which must be submitted or on file with the Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) before 5:00 p.m. on the dates indicated below:

##### Updates to Teletheatres

Any changes to the ownership or management of a teletheatre must be reported to the AGCO. Updates may require:
