Race 2, #5 AJ Chick in 15 popped the gate stall doors open prior to the start, was held in by handler and received a fair start when dispatched by starter. #4 Eye Got Yer Back was fractious prior to start and was off a step slow. Rest good

Race 3, Stewards' Inquiry, #1 Bending Over, 3rd, T. Harriot and #4 Wont Bac Down, 7th, R Castillo deep stretch. Upon review #1 is baring out as #2 backs away and #3 is forced out to #4, #4 has to check, costs a position. #1 was 3rd placed 7th for interference. NOR for T. Harriot and R. Castillo. T.
