Report on day's events:

Office:

- Notice of Certificate of Positive Analysis from 26 May Race 1 from VINTAGE MUSCLE (OM352), who finished 3rd, for phenylbutazone (Class 4) and its metabolites (Tag #4519146002). Trainer Donald Jobin notified and will attend the Judges office at Rideau for disclosure.

Races:

- Gilles Gendron excused from one drive.
1. Reviewed the start of #4 ASTERISM (Emil Toth), #4 suffered broken equipment (overcheck) after the start (confirmed by the driver), did receive a fair start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
 2. Discussed a drivers obligation when cutting the mile with Jacques Beaudoin (#5 DABUNKA) concerning the second quarter (27¹ 58¹); no penalty to Mr. Beaudoin. Clear.

 5. OKA #6 (Yves Filion) pulled up after the ¾ mile pole and qualifies for performance (trainer notified); #6 was examined after the race by the AGCO veterinarian who placed the horse on the short term veterinarian's list (sick). Clear.

 7. UPVOTE HANOVER #3 (Pascal Berube) suffered broken equipment (shoe) after the

start, and #6 PASADENA STAR (Stephane Pouliot) suffered broken equipment (head pole) before the ¼ mile pole; both finished with broken equipment. Clear.

9. Inquiry on #1 STONEBRIDGE FOCUS (Marie-Claude Auger) who broke before the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #1 did cause interference to the trailing horses (#s: 2, 3, 4, 7 and 8); #1 finished 3rd and was placed 8th (AGCO rule 22.09). Clear.

12. Breathalyzer retest. SPORTSCAM #7 (Guy Gagnon) broke at the ¼ mile pole, after the half, and pulled up; #7 qualifies for breaks and performance (trainer notified). Inquiry on #9 QUINTON BLUE CHIP (Marie-Claude Auger) who suffered broken equipment (hobble) before the start causing the horse to break; #9 pulled up and did not finish; refund: \$8465. Clear.
