- Lengthy delays posting the official results for the first two races as the tote board has been decommissioned and the order of finish must be posted on the television monitors causing the graphics system to crash.

 2. Late Judges scratch (ineligible; owner not licenced) of STPATTYS DAY, refund: \$101. Clear.

 4. Driver of #4 TOPVILLE CHROME, Gilles Gendron, cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
 5. Inquiry on #1 HP PANDORA (Marie-Claude Auger) who finished 2nd and #3 OLIVIA V (Pascal Berube) who finished 1st concerning possible interference at the ¾ mile pole; after speaking with both drivers (Mr. Berube stated his horse beared in and brushed the wheel of #1; Ms. Auger stated she was not impeded) and reviewing the video there was no placing; no penalty to Mr. Berube as the horse was clearly bearing in.
