Race 8 Breathalyzer retest. Inquiry. Reviewed race going to $\frac{3}{4}$'s for a possible break by # 2 Deuce Helie that finished 3rd. Horse did bear out but did not make a break in stride. No violations. Also, # 7 Showdown Seelster made a break before the start and was not inside the fair-start pole. Refund \$1023.

Race 9 Spoke to Nick Boyd regarding his urging. Reminded Mr. Boyd that the new urging rules will come into effect August 1st province wide.

Race 10 Inquiry. Drivers Objection # 7 Samara Johnson on # 9 Reg Gassien, the race winner, going to $\frac{3}{4}$'s. Reviewed race going to $\frac{3}{4}$'s. # 7 Show Me The Magic had been parked 1st over from the start. Going to $\frac{3}{4}$'s # 9 Four For Orr was 3 wide and # 6 Sunshine Inn was four wide. # 7 makes a break entering the turn with # 9 outside. Neither the back tower nor pan shot shows definitively that # 9 interferes with # 7. Also, Starter Steve Skene reported that while following the race he could not see # 9 cause # 7 to make a break. Objection disallowed.
