Trainer Sylvain Pion attended today to discuss why his horse English Illusion attended the training track turf course for a workout on Friday July 26, 2019. There seemed to be a mis-communication between race office and Mr. Pion.

Film Reviews:

Race 6 July 27, 2019. E. DaSilva and E. Wilson. Irwin Driedger as rep. E. Wilson had to check after the #2 came out from the 3 path to the 5 path at the top of the stretch on the inner and clipped heels. DaSilva felt that it's a bad spot at that point of the track and you can't see back. E. DaSilva issued a three day riding suspension. Days to be determined.

The running time for the 1mile and a half Nijinsky Stakes today was reported as being a New Track Record on the E. P. Taylor turf in Lane 3. This will be under review as there are some inaccuracies as to the Official time of the race.

Race 6, E. P. Taylor turf, #3 Letthebighossroll, K. Kimura, 9th and #6 Epilogue, E. Wilson, 3rd had to check into far turn as #9 Captain Sydney, J. Alderson, 4th tucked in for the run around the turn. Spoke with J. Alderson and asked that he leave a little more room for horses inside. No placings required.

Race 7, #10 Mazinaw Legend was off slow and trailed, rest ok.

Race 8, E. P. Taylor turf, Nijinsky Stakes, clear,

Race 9, #3 Glacier off a step slow and trailed, rest ok

Race 11, #8 Danzigity trailed throughout, #1 Eyes Forward bore out slightly top of stretch forcing #3 Stash the Cash, 4th and #4 Just Run With It, 1st, to bare out as well, #4 prevailed, #1 backed up to 7th.
