We were informed at 35 minutes to post that the TCO2 technician had only enough vials to test one horse in the first race. They had someone bringing them but was stuck in traffic. Decision was made to test one horse and the second selection would be tested 90 minutes post race. Supplies arrived before the second race and everything proceeded as normal.
