Yesterday at Woodbine the Stewards held a review with trainer Kevin Attard with regards to a class 4 positive analysis, Trichlormethiazide, of the horse Veraddassah which participated in the 4th race on July 10, 2019 at Woodbine racetrack. Mr. Attard was issued a 5 calendar day suspension and a monetary penalty of \$500.00, days to be determined.

Trainer Paula Loescher, signed notice of review, stable error scratch, \$300.00 monetary penalty. Tb #11203.

Jockey Agent Allan Raymond called to inform us that Apprentice Jockey Sharyn Nicole Alderson is no longer acting in that capacity. TB Ruling #11204 generated invalidating the license. Mr. Raymond also informed us that he is no longer representing Kirk Johnson as of August 10, 2019 and has picked up the book of Emile Ramsammy.

Call from Trainer Shane Meyers, Jockey Helen Vanek was named by the office as a rider was required at the time of the draw, would like to change to E. Ramsammy. Allowed the change but stressed that in the future he call to make change prior to the program going to print.

A call from Security relating to the owner of #1 Divine Ami in the second race trained by Daryl Ezra. It was reported that one of the owners was coming out of the stall after the horse had left for

the paddock. He was questioned on what he was doing, he stated they use a hand laser on the horse. Asked Security to file a report to us. Spoke with trainer D. Ezra, he informed us it was just a regular hand laser. We asked to bring it in for us.
