- SB HRAP 05026 2019 – Trevor Henry was granted a stay on SB 51018 from the Horse Racing Appeal Panel and is permitted to drive.

Races

Race 1 – All Clear

Race 2 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing after the half pertaining to #3 Silver Beast (Jonathan Drury), finished 3rd – horse goes wide on the turn but does not cause any interference or confusion to trailing horses. No violations.

- Reviewed racing around the final turn between #1 Nagle (LP Roy) and #6 The Regulator (Jody Jamieson). The horses hook wheels for a brief moment, both

horses were charted with 'interference'; no placings needed.

Race 3 – All Clear

Race 4 – All Clear. Judges spoke to Bob McClure (#6 Itaintezbeincheesy) regarding urging with acceptable wrist action.

Race 5 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the stretch between #2 Record Year (James MacDonald) and #5 Custom Cut (Bob McClure). #5 does come out in the stretch and cause interference to #2. #5 finished 3rd and was placed 4th. (Majority decision)

- Bob McClure – \$300 monetary penalty – did fail to keep both feet in the stirrups. AGCO Rule 22.19, SB 49635 (2nd offence within 6 months).

Race 6 – All Clear

Race 7 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing around the final turn and the break by #1 Loud Splash (Trevor Henry), finished 5th. #1 finished 5th and was placed 8th for causing interference to #2 Balder Son (Doug McNair), #5 Stonebridge Surf (LP Roy) and #6 Sports Teen (Sylvain Filion) while on a break.

Race 8 – Reviewed pylons on #1 Head To The Beach (Trevor Henry) in the first turn, finished 2nd – horse was inside one pylon and hit multiple pylons, no violations.

Race 9 – All Clear. #1 Lets Wait And See (Colin Kelly) finished the race with broken equipment (knee boot).

Race 10 – Inquiry X 2

- Inquiry #1 – Reviewed the break by #4 Alicorn (LP Roy) going to the quarter, finished 2nd – no violations of the breaking rule by #4.

- Inquiry #2 – Reviewed the start and break by #1 Preeminence (Paul MacDonell) – horse broke after the start and did not cause any interference to #9 All Day Sunshine (Sylvain Filion); all horses received a fair start.

- Reviewed pylons on #3 Queso Relleno (Jody Jamieson) in the stretch, finished 5th – horse was inside one pylon, no violations.

- Driver breathalyzer retest race.

Race 11 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing at the half between #2 Bettorbuckleup (LP

Roy) and #4 Beach Blanket Book (James MacDonald). #2 comes down and hooks wheels with #4. Driver Roy stated his horse was locked on a line and he couldn't keep him out. The two horses were unable to hook wheels and pulled up after the half. The following horses suffered interference: #4, #5 Sports Obsession (Jody Jamieson), #6 Mr Cheeseman (Trevor Henry), #7 Better B Swift (Sylvain Fillion), #8 Tabloid Writer (Mario Baillargeon), and #10 Colima (Doug McNair).
