Report on day's Events: (Backstretch - accidents, fines, suspensions, objections, disqualifications, refunds, pertinent incidents, general details etc., Film Reviews, Races, Claims)

Office:

13:30 – Trainer Jamie Attard attended to complain he had been given first call approximately a week and a half ago on two horses for Saturday September 28 by Jordan Miller for his rider Kazushi Kimura and was asked by Jordan the day before the draw if he could get off those horses. Jamie held Jordan to the calls, however, Jordan chose to ride for Mr. Casse instead leaving Mr. Attard to find other riders. We spoke with David Adams, assistant to Mr. Cassed who explained he had given Jordan the call on the horse "Special Honor" approximately two weeks ago but the call on "Chaldea" was given a couple days ago. We left Kazushi on "Special Honor" in the fifth race but removed him from "Chaldea" in race six and placed him on Jamie's horse "Foxy Power". Advised David Adams of our decision but unable to reach Jordan Miller at this time.

Film Reviews:

Review of Saturday September 21, race 8, involving Corey Jordan, Leo Salles and Irwin Driedger representing Juan Crawford. The review held after the second race in the Stewards stand due to the availability of riders earlier. Leo said he came off the fence turning for home but I didn't leave any room to my inside, I heard Corey and he got up inside then he pushed me out and we

interfered with horses to my outside. Corey said he saw the hole and got in there, said he felt Leo pushed down to him at first but he thought he got through ok. Irwin said on behalf of Juan Crawford, that the inside horses came out and he had to check hard and get out of there. It was evident Corey made his room then came out once in the hole, interfering with Leo and in turn Juan. We also reviewed Corey's use of the crop through the stretch. Corey was levied a three day suspension, Sunday September 29, Wednesday October 2 and Friday October 3, 2019.

Races:

Race 1 - #5 "Tishina" ridden by Jeffrey Alderson was away slow while #4 "Hitters Park" with Rafael Hernandez aboard breaks outward hard and contacting the #6 "Chiricahua Signal" with Eurico Da Silva. #6 finished ahead of #5, no Inquiry no change.

Race 2 – Stewards Inquiry into the start regarding #5 "Coolshade" ridden by Rafael Hernandez. It was noticed the doors opened slower than those of the rest of the field. In speaking with starter lan Ross he was told by his assistant that the horse tried to bite the bars. Rafael said he didn't realize at the time but after watching the video he realized the doors were slow opening. After review a refund of mutuels was ordered for an unfair start. #3 "Tale of Ronin" ridden by Luis Contreras broke sharply to the outside.
