### Office:

- Review with driver Rodney LaFromboise regarding his urging of GLOBAL SUPREMACY in the sixth race on 26 September; Mr. LaFromboise now has clarity on urging using only wrist action and will ensure he complies with these rules in future; no penalty.
- Trainer Gina Bragnolo attended the Judges office for disclosure.
- Trainer Luc Loyer was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rules: Standardbred Directive No. 1-2019, 6.53(a), 26.02.03(e) and 32.07 by medicating the horse BRIGADIERBRONSKI A in the paddock prior to the 7<sup>th</sup> race on 22 September 2019 and assessed a monetary penalty of \$500 (SB 50958).
- Discussed the outcome of the 1<sup>st</sup> race on 22 September with a patron who had concerns regarding the favourite finishing last. As was related to the patron, GA SPEEDY JOEY (Guy Gagnon) broke several times during the race and the panel did not consider the outcome to be unusual considering the class (2 YEAR OLDS, NW \$7,500 (FM \$9,375) LIFETIME) and the evolution of the race (refer to the AGCO Official Race Report for Rideau Carleton on 22 September).
