Said he spoke to someone at Fort Erie who told him that they had let him out as the race didn't fill. We spoke with the Fort Erie race office which relayed no one in the office spoke with Blair and yes the horse is on the overnight for Tuesday. We contacted Blair and advised he will remain entered for the Fort and he will be scratched from Woodbine. Mr. Miller is to attend our office tomorrow for a review.

Film Reviews:

Review with Leo Salles and Jeffrey Alderson, race 8 October 2, 2019. Jeffrey said as they were approaching the wire Leo's whip kept touching his horses face, intimidated my horse. Leo said they were so close together he couldn't use his whip, never thought he touched the other horse. After review it was clear that Leo did touch the other horse across the face on at least four occasions. Three day suspension levied to Leo for interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount.
