### Film Reviews:

Review of the eighth race on Sunday October 6 – The Cup & Saucer Stakes – involving Jerome Lermyte and Jesse Campbell for crop violations. Viewed the video with Jesse who was just at the helmet when using his crop, reminded him of the rules and to remain cautious about it for future. Jerome said he has viewed the video and doesn't deny he was well above his head when using his crop. Said he was trying to use the upcoming method of not cocking the whip and found it difficult. We advised that even with the new directive coming, the rules of over the head and consecutive strikes hasn't changed. Monetary penalty issued for Jerome of \$2,700.00 as per Directive No. 4 – 2009, Rule 9.27.07(a)

### Races:

Race 1 – Clear

Race 2 – Following the running we reviewed interference during the stretch run involving #5 "Shishka" ridden by Christopher Douglas and #9 "Irish Charm" ridden by Simon Husbands. We

did not post the Inquiry sign as they did not finish in the top four. Simon said the #5 drifted out on him and was on heels, had to check hard, was going to claim foul but didn't gallop around far enough. Christopher said his horse was lugging out with him. After review we disqualified #5 from fifth and place him seventh behind #9.
