Daisuke Fukumoto excused from his mounts today.

Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. called to inform he would not be able to fullfill his slated ride for the ninth race due to transportation issues. Excused.

Spoke with Jockey Jesse Campbell, has been away for two weeks, informed him of the new urging directive.

Woodbine management and the Jockeys discussed the first race slated for the E. P. Taylor turf, it was decided that the race would be run on the main Tapeta surface at the original 1 mile and 1/16 distance.

## Races:

Race 1, Off turf, 1 mile and 1/16 on main,#7 Super Patriotic bore out and slow start, #6 Strikingly Lovely pulled up on backstretch and did not finish, #4 Cherubic eased through stretch, rest good

Race 2, #8 Gimbala stumbled start, rest ok.

Race 3, #7 Big Cheeks off a step slow, #2 Candy's Dream was eased through stretch, spoke with J. Lermyte, stated the horse was just flat the last part of the race, rest good

Race 4, on advisement of the Official Veterinarian, #3 Awesome Halo was scratched prior to start, #2 bore out at start, #5 Donnie Brasco lugged in through stretch, #1 Synergized was eased, rest ok

Race 5, #5 Union Appreciation off slow, rest ok

Race 6, #1 Triglav off a step slow, rest good

Race 7, clear

Race 8, Maple Leaf Stakes, clear, as the horses moved in front of the grandstand for the first time, they appeared to move out off the rail in unison. Spoke with jockey Jesse Campbell who relayed that it was a very strong gust of wind.

Race 9, reviewed stretch run #6 City Boy, J. Campbell and #7 Yorkton, P. Husbands, as the #7 does move out slightly to its right at the 1/16<sup>th</sup>, does not appear to hinder the #6, rest ok

Race 10, #6 Boogie With Me, popped the doors on the gate stall prior to the official start, was held on to and re-loaded, rest ok. Caution to Jockey J. Lermyte, coming out late for the race, urging, hand above head level while making contact with his mount and raising up in the irons prior to the finish.
