**Report on day's Events:** (Backstretch - accidents, fines, suspensions, objections, disqualifications, refunds, pertinent incidents, general details etc., Film Reviews, Races, Claims)

### Office:

Agent J. Miller attended informed us that he did not accept a call with K. Kimura for trainer Suzanne Drake in today's first race. Would like to be excused, granted. We explained that we would like to be informed earlier in order for the trainer to obtain a replacement rider. In the event that a replacement is not available, requiring a scratch, a monetary penalty may be issued for failing to fulfill riding engagements.

The Stewards have recorded the following note regarding the newly implemented AGCO Directive 4-2019, urging rules 9.27.07 (d) and (e) where as a jockey cannot make contact with their crop in the 'cocked' position, or upward position, with their mount. There has been no noticeable or visible signs of safety with regards to the Jockeys riding in today's races. There have been no reports from the Official Veterinarians or Test Barn personnel regarding the welfare of the horse, cuts or welts.

### Film Reviews:

Race 10, November 23, 2019. R. Hernandez, C. Husbands, P. Husbands, J. Alderson and Ailsa Morrison. The race was marred by a few factors but could not fault one horse or rider, #8 outbreaks the #7 and #7 outbreaks horses to his inside, inside horses try to send up there as the #7 is moving laterally left and #2 is pinching from the inside. Jockeys had some concern of safety

and there was some positive discussions about future film reviews for educational purposes.

Race 5, November 22, 2019 Jerome Lermyte. Did not wish to review film, we informed him that we did observe a much concerted effort in yesterday's races and that we would continue to work with him regarding the change of style to urging to accommodate the new rules.

Jockeys David Cohen and Jevian Toledo tutored on our urging policy as they are here to ride the Stakes race and a few other races today.

Race 1, no back tower shot available as the operator was not attendant to the tower. Stewards Inquiry, #1 Wall Street Wolf, S. Singh 6<sup>th</sup>, checks hard down on the inside as well as the #4 You're Batman, L. Salles, 4<sup>th</sup>, around the 5 ½ furlong marker. Upon review of the apex and upper pan camera angles and speaking with the riders, #6 E. Ramsammy, 7<sup>th</sup> #5 R. Hernandez, 1<sup>st</sup>, #4 L. Salles, 4<sup>th</sup>, and #1 S. Singh, 6<sup>th</sup>, all riders felt that the #7 created a domino effect of interference down to the #1, #7 S. Civaci intimated that the #4 was not there to his inside. #7 was 3<sup>rd</sup> placed 7<sup>th</sup> for interference. NOR for S. Civaci
