Race 2 - All Clear

Race 3 – Reviewed pylons on #6 Bettim Vicky (LP Roy) at the top of the stretch, finished 2^{nd} – #6 was inside one pylon and hit one pylon; no violations of the pylon rule.

Race 4 – Inquiry – Reviewed possible pylon violation by #6 P L Nelly (Bob McClure) after the quarter, finished 4th. The back tower video shows #6 goes inside two consecutive pylons; lapped at the finish by #3 Baby Got Back (Sylvain Filion). AGCO Rule 18.08.02(a) reads, 'If a horse while on stride, or part of the horse's sulky, goes inside two (2) consecutive pylons, the offending horse shall be placed behind all horses that are lapped on to the offending horse at the wire.' #6 finished 4th and was placed 5th for a pylon violation.
