

Race 5 – Inquiry – Reviewed the break by #2 Waterfall (JR Plante) before the start – not inside Fair Start Pole, Refund #33,890. No Inquiry video available as the horse was too far back.

- #8 Southwind Milk (Matt Bax) was charted with interference due to the break by #9 Wearing The Green (Doug McNair) in the stretch, no placings needed.

Race 6 – All Clear

Race 8 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the stretch between #1 Twin B Archie (Jody Jamieson) and #9 Buck Dancer (Tyler Borth). The front tower video shows #9 is bearing out and puts a wheel under #1 as the horses are approaching the finish. The low pan video shows when #9 puts the wheel under #1, Jamieson is forced to stop driving and must check his horse to avoid hooking wheels. As a result, #9 finished 2<sup>nd</sup> placed 3<sup>rd</sup> for interference. No penalty to Borth as the horse is visibly bearing out and he is attempting to keep the horse straight.

Race 9 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #5 Simply The Best (Pascal Berube) in the stretch, finished 3<sup>rd</sup>. The front tower video shows #5 races inside two consecutive pylons; lapped by #4 Coeuratout Du Lac (LP Roy). #5 did not pass any horses while racing inside the pylons to gain an unfair advantage. As a result, #5 finished 3<sup>rd</sup> placed 4<sup>th</sup> for racing inside two consecutive pylons and being lapped at the finish.

- Reviewed pylons on #9 Sugar Pie Honey (James Macdonald) in the stretch, finished 1<sup>st</sup> races inside one pylon; no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 10 – Reviewed pylons on #5 Fashion Frenzie (LP Roy) in the stretch, finished 1<sup>st</sup> – hits three pylons and does not leave the course; no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 11 – Reviewed pylons on #7 Willowtime (LP Roy) around the final turn, finished 1<sup>st</sup> – races inside one pylon and hits multiple pylons; no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.
