Race 1:

#2 Run Away Sugarman (Isaacs) (1st) stumbled slightly at the start.

Race 2:

#5 Hours to Fly (Botello) (4th) dropped the rider after the race, **Botello** was examined and cleared to continue by E.M.S.

Race 3:

Trainer's Claim Of Foul #4 Hesmagicalydelicious (5th) (Castillo) against #3 Bar Ef Rushfurrcandy (Isaacs) (4th) and #5 The Zing Dynasty (Botello) (3rd) out of the starting gate. Isaacs "His horse stumbled and wasn't there at all". Botello "I was in my lane, and he turned me". Castillo "My horse stumbled a bit, but I was bothered by both of them". After video review, Stewards deemed #4 was stumbling when the initial contact occurred, and there wasn't sufficient evidence to warrant a change to the order of finish.

Race 7: \$29,835 Norman Picov Maturity

#7 Had to Be Ivory was a Vet scratch after being fractious in the gate.

Race 8: **#3 Hawkin the Straw (7th)** and **#6 Sassies Best (2nd)** both stumbled at the start. Spoke with rider **J.B. Botello** who said "I was just trying to get off the heels of **#2 Quick Willy** when I clipped, wasn't the fault of any other rider". Botello eased his horse after this for safety reasons.
