## Standardbred Official Ruling

**IN THE MATTER OF THE *HORSE RACING LICENCE ACT, 2015,*  
S.O. 2015, c.38, Sched. 9;  
AND IN THE MATTER OF THE HORSE WICKEDPACE**

Whereas the horse Wickedpace did race on June 14, 2025, in Race 10 at Woodbine Mohawk Park, programmed as horse #6 and driven by Jody Jamieson.

And whereas #6 Wickedpace was the unofficial 4<sup>th</sup> place finisher in Race 10.

And whereas the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario ("AGCO") Race Officials did receive a Driver's Objection from Kyle Husted, the driver of #7 Thebeautifulthings, against the #4 Perfectly Chic, driven by Bob McClure.

And whereas #7 was the unofficial 6<sup>th</sup> place finisher and #4 was the unofficial 5<sup>th</sup> place finisher.

And whereas the AGCO Race Officials posted the Inquiry Sign and looked at possible interference by #6 Wickedpace and #1 Cant See Me, driven by Louis-Philippe Roy.

And whereas after reviewing the video and speaking to drivers Bob McClure, Jody Jamieson, Kyle Husted, and Louis-Philippe Roy, it was determined by the AGCO Race Officials that #1 Cant See Me drifted off the rail and caused interference to #6 Wickedpace. In turn, #6 caused interference to #4, who then interfered with #7. It was ruled by the AGCO Race Officials that #1 Cant See Me was held responsible and at fault. Horse #s 4, 6, and 7 were all deemed to have suffered interference from #1.

And whereas AGCO Standardbred Rule 22.09 states:

'In the case of interference, collision, or violation of any rules, the offending horse may be placed back one or more positions in that heat or dash, and in the event of such collisions, interference or violation preventing any horse from finishing the heat or dash, the offending horse may be disqualified from receiving any winnings and the driver may be assessed a

monetary penalty or suspended. If a horse is set back, it must be placed behind the horse with which it interfered. If an offending horse has interfered with a horse involved in a dead heat and the offending horse is set back, it must be placed behind the horses in the dead heat.'

And whereas #1 finished behind all horses that she interfered with, no placings were required and the Driver's Objection was disallowed.
