Race 1, #2 Papa Chase Now slight stumble at start, rest ok

Race 2, Jockey claim of foul, #3 C. Jeschke, 3rd on #4, A. Sanchez, 1st after the start, #2, R. Isaacs on #3 through stretch. Upon review of the front tower and upper pan camera angles, #2 creates the issue for #3 and #4 is not responsible for the room diminishing between the #3 and #4. Claim of fouls were disallowed.

Race 4, All clear

Race 5, it was reported by the Starter that the attachment for the flipping halter in stall #5, Kati on Fire, was not operational and the horse would have to not have the flipping halter attached, this was announced to the public on the public address system and added to the video feed on the TV monitors.

Race All clear

Race 6, Stewards' Inquiry, #2 R. Isaacs, 4th and #3, C Jeschke, 5th approaching finish. Upon review of upper pan and front tower camera angles, #2 does bare out quickly into #3 and curbs that one's momentum and cost #3 4th position. #2 finished 4th and subsequently placed 5th for the interference. No penalty issued to Jockey R. Isaacs as it was horse error.
