**IN THE MATTER OF THE *HORSE RACING LICENCE ACT, 2015*,
S.O. 2015, c.38, Sched. 9;
AND IN THE MATTER OF CHRISLIN C NOTHER**

On May 19, 2022, the standardbred horse "TRIDENT SEELSTER" (freeze brand #7MN37) finished fourth (4th) in the tenth (10th) race at Flamboro Downs Raceway. TRIDENT SEELSTER is trained by Chrislin NOTHER "NOTHER".

On May 21, 2022, Racing Forensics Inc. reported that the blood sample with Test Tag number 332213919, contained TC02 with a value measured at 37.6 mmol/L.

TAKE NOTICE that based on the above NOTHER is found to have violated 22.38(a), 26.02.01, 26.02.02 and 26.02.03 (d) of the Rules of Standardbred Racing.

In accordance with Rules 6.04 and 22.38.06 of the Rules of Standardbred Racing and Policy Directive 1-2018, NOTHER is hereby fully suspended for FORTY FIVE days (45) (September 2, 2022 to October 16, 2022, inclusive) and issued a monetary penalty of twenty five hundred dollars (\$2,500) dollars.

TAKE NOTICE that all horses owned in whole or in part are suspended and are not eligible to race during the suspension period. All horses may with the consent of the AGCO Racing Officials be released to another trainer in accordance with Rules 6.13.01 and 26.08. All purse monies shall be returned for redistribution. In accordance with Rules 9.13 and 18.08.01, TRIDENT SEELSTER is hereby declared unplaced for all purposes, with the exception of Pari-Mutuel Wagering. The revised order of finish for Race 10 at Flamboro Downs Raceway on May 19, 2022 is as follows:

#1 TRIDENT SEELSTER - disqualified

The following terms are added to NOTHER license: two years of probation commencing (October 17, 2022 to October 16, 2024, inclusive), pursuant to Rule 6.04 of the Rules of Standardbred Racing and Policy Directive No. 3-2008.

1. The Licensee is required to complete the AGCO Equine Medication Use and Awareness Program before reinstatement;
2. The Licensee shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
3. The Licensee may be subject to a Notice of Proposed Order in addition to any penalty imposed by the AGCO Race Officials for any breach of the terms of their license.
