**IN THE MATTER OF THE *HORSE RACING LICENCE ACT, 2015*,
S.O. 2015, c.38, Sched. 9;
AND IN THE MATTER OF Tommie D Dunlap LICENCE NO. HP132462**

On August 5, 2020 Bureau Veritas Canada (2019) INC., reported that the urine sample with Test Tag 70 20204 001, revealed a positive reading for the Class 4 drug Flunixin. The sample was obtained from the Quarter Horse "ME ZOOMN BY" (TATTOO #132G2) which finished first (1st) in the first (1st) race on July 22, 2020, at Ajax Downs. ME ZOOMN BY is trained by Tom Dunlap "DUNLAP".

On June 30, 2018 DUNLAP was issued Ruling Number 10798/18 for a Class 4 Positive Test;

TAKE NOTICE that based on the above DUNLAP is found to have violated 15.06.01 (a), (b) and 15.06.03 (c) of the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing.

Accordingly, pursuant to 15.04.02.2, 15.05.01, and 24.01 of the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing and Policy Directive No. 1 – 2018, DUNLAP is hereby fully suspended for thirty (30) days (May 9, 2021 – June 7, 2021 inclusive) and issued a monetary penalty of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) dollars.

In accordance with Alcohol, Gaming and Racing Thoroughbred Rule 15.04.03, "ME ZOOMN BY" is hereby declared unplaced for all purposes with the exception of Pari-Mutuel Wagering. The revised order of finish for Race 1 at Ajax Downs on July 22, 2020 is as follows:

1 st	#3	Sr Blue Hawk
2 nd	#5	Goodness Graceious
3 rd	#1	Kitsawinner

Me Zoomn By - unplaced

The following terms are added to DUNLAP's licence: two years of probation commencing (June 8, 2021 until June 7, 2023), pursuant to Rule 16.13(g) of the Rules of Thoroughbred Racing and Policy Directive No. 3-2008:

1. The Licensee shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour;
2. The Licensee shall allow Commission Inspectors access to his stabling area at any time to conduct unannounced random searches for illegal or non-therapeutic medications or drugs;
3. The Licensee shall allow commission inspectors to seize any illegal or non-therapeutic medications or drugs found at his stabling area;
4. The Licensee shall be subjected to the AGCO's Out of Competition Program; and
5. The Licensee may be subject to a Notice of Proposed Order in addition to any penalty imposed by the AGCO Stewards for any breach of the terms of their license.
