Race 1 – All clear.

Race 2 – All clear.

Race 3 – Reviewed racing after the start. Both “Validation” #2 and “The Reins Of Titan” #7 made breaks in stride on their own.

Race 4 – All clear.

“Blue Monk” #6 finished with broken equipment (both front shoes).

Race 5 – All clear.

Race 6 – Recall charged to #1 “Zeke the Freak” (Ondrej Gois). Ondrej Gois violation of AGCO rule 22.03 (i) (l), did score ahead of the starting gate. Monetary penalty of \$100 by order of the Starter.

Race 7 – All clear.

Race 8 – Judges inquiry at the start. “Red Hot Torch” #1 (Jason Ryan), the 4th place finisher, made a break in stride before the start. He had broken equipment (martingale) after the start. Horse did not violate any of the breaking rules. No placing.

“Massive Potential” #9 (Paul MacKenzie), the 3rd place finisher, received a fair start. No refunds.
