- Judges spoke to Howard Taylor regarding his client, Dean Eckley. Mr. Taylor was made aware that the Alliance racetracks have not accepted entries from Mr. Eckley since 2019 and his status has not changed.

Race 1 – All Clear

Race 2 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #7 Running On Luck (Travis Cullen) at the 5/8ths, finished 4<sup>th</sup>. The pan video shows #7 races inside two consecutive pylons; lapped by #2 Strait Tothe Point (Darcy Clancy) at the finish. #7 finished 4<sup>th</sup> placed 5<sup>th</sup> for a pylon violation. No penalty to Cullen as the horse is visibly running in on the turns.

- Reviewed pylons on #4 U R Asurprise Tome (Austin Sorrie) around the final turn, finished 1<sup>st</sup> – horse hits multiple pylons and is not inside the pylons.

The Judges activated the Siren for safety concerns coming at the half as #5 continued behind the field. Refund \$21,545.
