Race 7 – Reviewed the break by #7 Plausibldniability (Ed Hensley) after the half. The horse made a break while on the lead and caused interference to #1 Big Cheddar (Stephen Byron), #3 Keepingasecret (Lyle MacArthur), #5 Win The Deal (J Harris), #6 American Land (John Flanigan), and #8 Dash Doll (Dave Duncan). #2 Bombella (Scott Coulter) was charted with an ix. #7 finished 7th placed 8th for causing interference while on a break.

- Reviewed #5 Win The Deal (J Harris) around the final turn, finished 5th – horse gets rough but does not make a break.

Race 8 – Reviewed the break #5 Texaco Man (JR Plante) in the first quarter. #7 Brydown Houston (Scott Coulter) was charted with interference. No placings needed.

Race 9 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #7 Grammys Girl (Scott Coulter) at the 5/8th, finished 5th – horse goes inside two consecutive pylons (not lapped at the finish) and hits multiple pylons around the turn – no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.
