**IN THE MATTER OF THE *HORSE RACING LICENCE ACT, 2015*,
S.O. 2015, c.38, Sched. 9;
AND IN THE MATTER OF JOSHUA E. MCKIBBIN**

On January 5, 2023, the standardbred horse "DO YOU SEE IT" (tattoo number 5RM07) finished third (3rd) in the seventh (7th) race at Woodbine Mohawk Park Raceway. DO YOU SEE IT is trained by JOSHUA MCKIBBIN "MCKIBBIN". The horse provided a pre-race blood sample identified by unique test tag number 532300513. DO YOU SEE IT is in the EIPH program.

On January 8, 2023, Racing Forensics Inc. reported that the blood sample with Test Tag number 532300513, contained TC02 with a value measured at 39.5 mmol/L.

TAKE NOTICE that based on the above MCKIBBIN is found to have violated 22.38(b), 26.02.01, 26.02.02 and 26.02.03 (d) of the Rules of Standardbred Racing.

In accordance with Rules 4.02(i), 6.04 and 22.38.06 of the Rules of Standardbred Racing and Policy Directive 1-2018, MCKIBBIN is hereby fully suspended for one year (April 28, 2023 to April 27, 2024, inclusive) and issued a monetary penalty of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) dollars.

TAKE NOTICE that all horses owned in whole or in part are suspended and are not eligible to race during the suspension period. All horses may with the consent of the AGCO Racing Officials be released to another trainer in accordance with Rules 6.13.01 and 26.08. All purse monies shall be returned for redistribution. In accordance with Rules 9.13 and 18.08.01, DO YOU SEE IT is hereby declared unplaced for all purposes, with the exception of Pari-Mutuel Wagering. The revised order of finish for Race 7 at Woodbine Mohawk Park Raceway on January 5, 2023 is as follows:

#3 DO YOU SEE IT - disqualified

The following terms are added to MCKIBBIN license: two years of probation commencing (April 28, 2024, to April 27, 2026 inclusive), pursuant to Rule 4.02(i), and 6.04 of the Rules of Standardbred Racing and Policy Directive No. 3-2008.

1. The Licensee is required to complete the AGCO Equine Medication Use and Awareness Program before reinstatement;
2. The Licensee may be subject to a Notice of Proposed Order in addition to any penalty imposed by the AGCO Race Officials for any breach of the terms of their license.
