Office:

- Some of the paperwork for the card today had tattoos for four of the two-year-old first-time starters omitted. The Race Office had erred by not entering the information into the encompass system. The error was rectified, and the horses were properly identified by the Association Veterinarians, the Stewards, Paddock Judge and Horse Identifier.
- The Stewards held a review with Jockey Miguel Nicholls. Mr. Nicholls has ridden five races in a satisfactory manner and will be allowed to carry a crop.
- Test Strips utilized in races three and five.

Race 1:

Stewards Inquiry reviewed the break by #2 Princess Leia (Ramiro Castillo), (finished fifth). The Assistant Starter was attempting to straighten the horse in the stall when the doors opened. The Stewards determined that the Assistant Starter interfered with the start of the horse and #2 Princess Leia was a complete parimutuel refund. The doors for #2 do open slower due to the horse leaning on the flipping halter, this was not the reason for the refund.

Inquiry Video: https://youtu.be/DM8gHMUsnG4 Reviewed racing between #3 Chiseled Man (Helen Vanek), (finished sixth and was placed seventh) and #1 Jls Deans Dynasty (Cory Spataro), (finished seventh and was placed sixth). The Stewards spoke to Jockey Helen Vanek who said her horse was erratic. #3 finished sixth and was placed seventh for causing interference to #1.

Race 2:

- The Stewards cautioned Jockey Miguel Nicholls (#1 Down Home Possum), (finished fifth) about going more than three consecutive strikes while using his crop. The Warning was entered in iAGCO.

This was Mr. Nicholls first race carrying a crop, he will be in for a review with the Stewards on Sunday June 19, 2022.

Race 3:

#1 A Shades Of Cold (Ismael Mosqueira) was fractious in the gate and was subsequently scratched by the Stewards.
