**Report on day's Events:** (Backstretch - accidents, fines, suspensions, objections, disqualifications, refunds, pertinent incidents, general details etc., Film Reviews, Races, Claims)

### Backstretch:

- Test strips were utilized in races two and three.

### Race 1:

- #4 Big E (Ismael Mosqueira), (finished second) was away slowly.

### Race 2:

- Stewards Inquiry, Trainers claim of foul #4 Miss Orient Express (Ramiro Sanchez), (finished fourth placed third) on #1 I Think Icon (Ed Walton), (finished first placed fifth). Also, a Jockeys claim of foul #2 Five Bar Fandango (Josh Scott), (finished fifth placed fourth) on #1.  
#1 drifts outward across the track in front of the #2 where the #2 catches the heels of the #1. The #1 continues outward across the path of the #4 causing the #4 to take hold.  
#1 finished first and was placed fifth for causing interference to #2 and #4.
