Report on day's events:

Office:

- Early Judges scratch (transportation) of MIDNIGHT SURF from the seventh race.
- Driver Jimmy Gagnon has been given a deadline of 25 June to pay his outstanding monetary penalty from 17 March.

Races:

- William Roy excused from two drives.
 - Pascal Berube and Alain Fillion each excused from one drive.
1. Due to a malfunction the electronic photo finish was not available; Judge's decision final per AGCO rule 33.09; upon reviewing the finish using the race video it was not possible to separate the second and third finishers and a dead heat for place was declared between #2 ASHLEES SUPREME (Drew Smyth) and #3 POWERCHICK (Jeffrey Egan). Clear.

 3. Driver of #2 FRIAR VOLTAIRE, Jimmy Gagnon, was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.05.01(k) (failure to set a pace comparable to class) pertaining to the second quarter (29 101) and was assessed a monetary penalty of \$100 (Number 2224053). Clear.

4. Late Veterinary scratch (lame) of DIEHL by the AGCO Veterinarian, Dr. L. Attack-Berthiaume; refund: \$1017; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians List. Clear.
