- 1. Reviewed the performance of #1 LIGHT THE TORCH (Jacques Beaudoin) after the start; #1 did contact several pylons; no violation of the inner rail rule. The teletimer was not functional for the first race; race fractions: 28<sup>3</sup> 58 127<sup>2</sup> 157<sup>2</sup>. Clear.

- 3. Discussed crossing over abruptly after the start with the driver of #6 SPRINGBRIDGE JIM, Andrew Moore. Clear.
