### Back Office:

- Test strips were utilized in races four and five.
- Driver Jean Rene Plante was found to be in violation of AGCO rule 6.02 (a) (*Failing to fulfil his driving engagement*) and is subject to a \$50 monetary penalty. AGCO ruling #2282033. The violation occurred in the sixth race when scheduled to drive the horse True Horizon.

R1 – #5 Katys Delight (Travis Henry), (pulled up, did not finish) stumbled and broke a hopple hanger shortly after the start. #5 pulled up due to broken equipment.

R2 – All clear.

R3 – All clear.

R4 – #3 Saulsbrook Jessie (Brett Macdonald), (pulled up and did not finish) had a hopple hanger break that caused the horse to make an equipment break, and then pulled up after the quarter with broken equipment.

R5 – All clear.

R6 – All clear.

R7 – The Judges cautioned Driver Steve Byron (#5 Dewitt This Moment), (finished fifth) about using more than acceptable wrist action. The warning was entered into the iAGCO portal.

R8 – Judges inquiry. Reviewed racing at the top of the stretch between #9 Roulette Hanover (Steve Byron), (finished first and was placed fourth) and #7 Dream Of Jeannie (Daryl Thiessen), (finished fourth and was placed third). #9 comes out in the stretch and interferes with the #7. #9 finished first and was placed fourth for causing interference to #7. Driver Steve Byron will attend the Judges office for a film review tomorrow.
