Back Office:

- Test strips were utilized in races five and six.
- Drivers Jay Harris and Jody Jamieson were excused from their drives this evening.
- Driver Jason Ryan was in to review his urging with the Judges from Georgian Downs in race nine on July 25, 2023. Mr. Ryan explained that he understands what is expected of him and his urging style going forward.
- Trainer James K. Ellis was found to be in violation of AGCO rule 22.24 (*late equipment change*). The violation occurred in race five tonight with the horse Thirdtimesacharm. Mr. Ellis is subject to a \$200 monetary penalty. Ruling #2282862.
- Driver Steve Byron was found to be in violation of AGCO rule 22.05.01 (d) (causing interference to another horse). The violation occurred July 29, 2023, while driving the hose Roulette Hanover in race eight. Mr. Byron is subject to a three-day driving suspension that shall be served August 8 through tenth

R4 – Reviewed the break by #1 Lookproud (Brett Macdonald), (finished fifth). #1 makes a break before the quarter. There were no violations of the breaking rules.

R6 – Judges inquiry. Reviewed the break by #2 Larjon Lucky (Trevor Henry), (finished ninth) before the start. #2 was not inside the fair start pole at the start of the race and was a complete refund (\$5,729)
