Race 1, Inner Turf, All clear

Race 2, #4 Unilateral off a step slow as #5 Taradar did bare in at the start, rest ok

Race 3, #1 Fifth Season, at the break, hit the stall doors on the way out and fell behind, rest good.

Race 4, Inner Turf, #5 Luv To Win unseated R. Hernandez behind the gate as they were loading into the gate, ran off to the frontside on turf and was subsequently a Steward scratch (Refund: \$77,301). All clear

Race 5, All clear,

Race 6, Inner turf, Jockey claim of foul. #5 Celentano, J. Stein, 3<sup>rd</sup> on #6 Kid Marvelous, K. Kimura, 3<sup>rd</sup>, just after the start. After review of the back tower and upper pan camera angles, #6 is dropping as #4 does take a step out, #5 does steady a step but the #6 is clear. The claim of foul is disallowed.

Race 7, #7 Last Monarch was fractious behind the gate and it was advised by the starter the horse be scratched. Stewards Inquiry, #8 Gizmo's Mission, start, upon review of the back tower camera angle, the stall doors of #8 do open slower than the rest of the field hindering the start. A complete refund was ordered due to an unfair start. Total refund for the race \$260,372.

Stewards inquiry #10 rat Portage, K. Nicholls, 3<sup>rd</sup>, #4 Mr. Marshall, D. Carroll and #6, Heezaspeedy, J. Stein. Upon review of back tower and upper pan it was inconclusive as to the aggressor of the situation when #6 is forced to check as the room is diminished. No change to the order was made.
