Race 1, #5 Miss Goodie Goodie, unseated A. Vandermeersch in post parade and was subsequently a Steward scratch (Refund \$2,095). #4, Hardroadtoglory very fractious from paddock to gate. Race clear

Race 2, All clear

Race 3, #1 Musical Flight stumbled start, rest ok

Race 4, Turf, All clear

Race 5, Summer Solstice Cup, reviewed run through far turn regarding, #2 Shes Astylish Katz, P. Mailhot, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and #4 Cloud Runner, J. Crawford, 12<sup>th</sup>, no placings necessary. Rest ok.

Race 6, JCOF, #6, M. Pinto, 3<sup>rd</sup> on #7, C. Husbands, 1<sup>st</sup>, after the start. Upon review of all camera angles afforded to the Stewards, #7, after the start is outrun by #8 to his outside and appears to shy away and comes in slightly. #6 appears to shy from #7, Mr. Husbands pulls off quick to correct his horse. Pinto felt her horse was impeded and forced her over to the inside. Husbands stated his horse shied and didn't feel he interfered with her.

The claim of foul was disallowed.

Jockey Wilbert Gobay cited for possible urging violation. Notice of review for next week

Race 7, Reviewed racing after the start as inside horses had to ease back when room diminished between them, it was inconclusive as to which rider or horse created the issue. Rest ok

Race 8, All clear

Race 9, Turf, reviewed racing into the far turn, #1, Fade Away 3<sup>rd</sup>, lugged out onto heels of #2 and #3. No violations

Race 10, Sprint into Summer Cup, Stewards Inquiry regarding the run into the far turn. #8, Wonnefrac unseated Jockey Omar Moreno. After review of back tower, apex and upper pan camera angles and speaking with Omar Moreno, it was determined that #4 Invisible Friend, Ismael Mosqueira, 3<sup>rd</sup> did in fact bump #8 forcing that one over heels and then clipping the heel of #10 M V Speed.

#4 Invisible Friend was 3<sup>rd</sup> and placed 7<sup>th</sup> and last for interference.
