

Report on day's events:

Office:

Ryan Holliday excused from nine (9) drives today.

Early Vet scratches (sick) of STORMONT TIM from the second race; STEELY DAWN from the third race, and ARSENAL DE CHAFRA from the seventh race; these horses are entered on the short term vet list.

Races:

R1 – Reviewed the break of #3 STANFORD SEELSTER (P. Davies, 6th) after the start and after the ¹/₄. No violations.

R2 – INQUIRY concerning breaks after the start on winner #4 RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE (C. Kelly) and #7 CHILI N TOAST (N. Steward, 4th). #7 makes a break after the start and pulls clear to the outside, no violations. #4 makes a break halfway around the turn and pulls clear into the safety lane, no violations. #6 LAVECS MUSCLE GIRL (B. Richardson, 6th) breaks stride coming out of the turn, #1 and #5 charted with interference, no placings required.

R3 – Clear

R4 - #2 VINTAGIOUS (B. Richardson, 6th) broke stride before the start and did not cause interference to the trailing horse. VINTAGIOUS has two consecutive breaks, the previous break was on an off track. The trainer was notified that the horse is still eligible to enter.

#8 ALLY FLIGHT (J. Gaskell) was distanced and must qualify for performance.

R5 - #4 BIG LADY J (R. Desroche, 8th) did not want to get up on the gate, got away rough and did break stride in the first turn. Spoke to the trainer who said she had changed the equipment for this race and will make a correction moving forward.

R6 – INQUIRY on winner #3 FERN HILL BREEZE (P. Keetch). Reviewed pylons in the first turn. The driver was inside two pylons but not lapped on at the finish. No violations. The driver Pat Keetch was cautioned about his urging style and a warning was added to his licence.

R7 – Clear

R8 – Clear - Following this race the Judges were informed that the water truck had malfunctioned. No water on the track for the rest of the race card.

Received a call from trainer John Gaskell requesting that we review R4. He felt his horse ALLY FLIGHT was bothered in the first turn causing the horse to be distanced. The film review does not support this. The horse must qualify.

R9 - #1 GOTAGETMESOMATHAT (P. Keetch) lost a shoe in the race and finished with broken equipment (BE). Cautioned driver Corrie German about his urging style and a warning was added to his licence.
