R1 – Reviewed pylons on winner #1 MACHAPELO (A. Sorrie) after the ½ pole. Inside one, no violations.

R2 – Reviewed pylons on winner #3 ALLY FLIGHT (N. Steward) in the last turn. Inside one, no advantage gained, no violations.

R3 – Clear.

R4 – INQUIRY. Reviewed racing at the ¾ pole. Winner #4 COMING YOUR WAY (T. Henry) takes advantage of room on the inside of #3 STILETTO BLUE CHIP (C. Kelly) who drifts off the rail preparing for the turn. #3 subsequently forces #4 inside pylons. The Judges cautioned Colin Kelly about keeping the rail covered, even when heading into the turn. The Judges also requested the Official Vet to check #2 ROLLWITHITJESSIE (N. Day) who made a couple of breaks in the race. The vet confirmed the horse was not lame.
