Second inquiry and Jockey claim of foul, #6 I'm Into Mischief (Eswan Flores), (finished eighth, placed seventh) on #1 Hai Bobbi (Sofia Vives), (finished second, placed eighth). #6 is between horses as the #1 drifts out to the #6 causing the #6 to check.
