We also spoke with Rafael Hernandez aboard #2 “Ninetyfour Expos” and Gary Boulanger aboard #10 “War Strategy” who were both to the inside of Justin. Justin said he had horse and the hole closed, saw Eswan’s horse was laying in with him so figured it was he who got me, upon looking at the video, I see the inside horses came out. Eswan said he never went in, horse was lugging with him but I had him and kept straight. Rafael said he stayed straight, kept my path. Gary said his horse was dying and just tried to stay out of everybody’s way. After review, it was apparent the inside horses did come out into Justin’s path causing him to check and lose momentum. #2 was disqualified from fourth position and place eighth behind number eight.
